Shortfilm „Black & White“, Robi Zuts

For my thesis I made a short film titled „Black & White“. This was a challenge for myself, since I've always wanted to make a film like this. The film talks about a colorblind boy named Glen who has caught feelings for Hanna a while ago but has since then not written her anything. As time goes on, they start talking to each other on the internet and soon after he is shocked by the news that Hanna has an exhibition coming up in Tartu. This news causes a lot of panic in Glen and is a turning point in the movie, since he knows he can't tell Hanna that he is colorblind. Glen and his two friends Fred and Lauri start thinking of ways to impress Hanna.

The film turned out to be 18 minutes long and it took two full days to film, not including the editing time. During this thesis I learned a lot about making films, writing scripts and leading a 12 people filming crew as a director. In addition to the film, I also learned about how and why different film scenes and their compositional structures make us feel certain emotions. I also used this knowledge in my own film, really thinking what emotion I want to show in certain scenes. I also introduced myself to the colorblindness in general since it was mandatory for me to get to know the subject when making a film about it. Making this film made me realize how much I like films and making one myself really opened my eyes to new opportunities.
